

I have waited to answer your letter until I had a chance to see Capt. Pirnie, who commanded Amon Jr. 's battery. I am sure that you already know this but I know as a father that such news is always wlecome; even though it is repeated. I enjoyed recieving the pictures and had the opportunity to show them to Walter Jennings, Stephen Brady and a few bohers from Fort Worth. Maybe some incident will o cur that will get him out soon. I know that he has done his part alregely; and the rest of the party should be up to some of the rest. The cleanup, I hope, isn't far off. We all have nothing to regret in that we feel that we are trying to do our part but the U.S. is still the best looking soil I have ever seen and Ft. Worth, of course is the best of it. The Texas flag flies daily in our area and wherever you go you do not seea Texan that isn't damn proud of being one and usually isn't very timid about mentioning it. 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
