Dear Mr. Brown: Distressed to learn of War Department's reporting Paul's serious injury Fourteenth and fully sympathize with you in your anxiety and only wish there were some way I could help you PERIOD It is impossible to get a telegram through to Colonel Sommerall or anyone else. Paul's friends in the battalion would give you any information possible if they could PERIOD My son, Amon Junior, being in the same battalion has kept me anxiously awaiting some word from him. Have had nothing since February Fourth PERIOD The War Department in Washington is the only avenue of information and they have a rather definite policy of handling all cases; however feel sure they will keep you posted on any change in Paul's condition, so please cheer up and look on the brightest side possible awaiting further developments PERIOD If I hear any information will immediately phone or wire you and will appreciate hearing from you likewise.
