Dear Mr. Carter:

I received the papers you sent with the notice of your son Amon's capture by the Germans and I am relieved to know he is alive, but sorry he is a prisoner.

We had a letter from Paul on May 7th that was dated March 4th, saying he was captured by the Germans, was interned at camp 201- Military Post 3450 in Italy. He said he had a slight leg injury that was healing quickly. Treatment was good. Also got the same information from Provost Marshall Washington.
