We fought in the Mak-nassy Sector and in the Bizute Sector. When we went back by Ford Pass, we searched for some trace of Amon or his things. But we found nothing.

I would like to have Amon's address so I can write to him direct. Both the men and the officers who knew Amon think of him often.
