Germany - I read some time ago that you were a prisoner of war in Germany but it wasn't brought home to me so shockingly until I got to Fort Worth today and stopped off at your Dad's little cubby hole. Of course I miss seeing you and I imagine that right now, even a face like mine would look kinda good to you.

Seriously though Amon, as long as you had to be captured let's all be glad that you were taken by the Germans. As you know I was over there in the last war and was in Coblentz Germany following the armistice and was never treated better in my life.

I don't want to break your heart but thought you might want to know that I am going to take a ride on your beautiful boat this afternoon. I hope it rides easier than that big palimino horse I rode this morning. Your dad thought I was a little behind in my exercise, so we went out and roped a couple of long horned steers.

Your Dad tells me that you are going to invite some of the German officers over to your ranch after the war. I just hope it will be very soon. In the meantime, the best of luck
