Dear Mr. Carter:

I have received another letter from Edward which was written Jan. 8. In this letter he says "I am in the hospital for minor repair job. Will be out in a few days". That is all that he said about that and then started talking about some books he had read. I don't know why he was in the hospital. I suppose that will be the last of that group of letters and it will probably be six weeks or two months before I will receive any later news. I don't suppose your son mentioned Edward's being sick or in the hospital to you, but if he does, I wish you would let me know what he says about it.

The rest of the letter was about as usual.

I mailed him another package yesterday. He always asks for as much candy as possible, so about 3 pounds was candy,  $\frac{1}{2}$  box of tea, 2 lb. box of cheese, 1 lb. raisins, 2 boxes of Vitamins Plus, and some underwear which he had also asked for. He seems to have received all the packages I had sent through September by Jan. 1.
