I want to thank you for sending the telegram, informing me that Oflag 64 had been moved. I had been anxious to know just what had happened to them.

If they are still at Stalag Luft III it wont be long until the Russians catch up with them again anyway. I believe they will soon be home now.

My latest card from Edward was written Dec. 14. Mrs. John Stansell of Olden wrote that she had a letter dated Dec. 17. They had received some packages, and were happy about that. In Edward's Dec. 3 letter he said that Weldon Maple of Fort Worth was in the camp and for me to write his wife, but he did not give any street address. He is from Texas A. & M. too.

I hope that our next news will be that the boys are free and on their way home.

I'll be glad for you to call or wire me collect on any news you may receive of them.
