I still haven't heard anything from my husband, Lt. Edward G. Batte. I have appreciated the information which you have sent me very much. I hadn't written because I didn't know any news, and I keep hoping that I will hear that Edward had been freed too.

My last letter was written Dec. 31 from Oflag 64. Since I haven't heard from any other camp, I feel like there is a good chance that he has been liberated, but I don't really know anything for sure. I saw the picture in the Fort Worth Star-Telegram this afternoon, but I couldn't recognize anyone.

Just as soon as I receive any news of his whereabouts, I will let you know. When you here anything, I will appreciate it if you will let me know.

I hope Amon Jr. and Edward are in Odessa, waiting for a boat home. Maybe the War Department hasn't received all the names yet.
