Dear Mr. Carter:

I was so glad to know that you had talked to Amon Jr. and that he was all right. Did he get to come home with you? I was also glad to know that John Jones Jr. and Robt. T. Henry, Jr. were with him.

I just wondered if Amon Jr. or John Jones Jr. knew anything about Edward. I haven't heard anything from him or about him since the letter he wrote March 1 from Parchim, saying he was going to Hammelburg. Mrs. Jones of Houston told me that Lt. Cecil of Houston told her that Edward and John Jr. left "flag 64 together, walking. That they packed their clothes and food on a sled together, but I don't know if John went to Parchim or not.

Mrs. Joe Emerson of Handley had a letter from Joe, saying he was at Parchim and going to Hammelburg. Then later, a friend of theirs wrote her that Joe was seen at Nurnberg on April 2 and was in good health, but still with the Germans. I suppose Edward was still with him. She hadn't heard any more from Joe, either.

I am certainly glad that Amon Jr. is all right. I hope that we will soon hear from the other Texas boys.
