In the absence of Mr. Carter, who is out of the State, I am taking the liberty of forwarding to you a copy of a letter which he received this morning, enclosing a set of pictures taken in Oflag 64, Germany. Most of them deal with the funeral of Captain Richard Torrence of Waco. However, Lt. Beasley might be in the group, so I am sending all of them.

The picture of about 30 boys on the steps carries a notation, "Taken in January 1944. All the Texans in Oflag 64, more have arrived since then". They all seem to be in good spirits and looking fine. On the back of one of the pictures it says, "Taken in January wearing new overcoats".

I am sure you will get as much pleasure out of receiving these as we have and I am glad to send them along.
