In going through an accumulation of unanswered mail on my desk, I found your letter of February 20 enclosing a letter from Captain Bergman dated December 25 as well as a picture of a group of Texans taken in the prison camp in January, 1944, for which please accept my thanks.

Please accept my apology for not returning this letter and picture more promptly; however, I had been hoping from day to day to have news of the boys in Oflag 64 to pass along to you. Mrs. Poteet of Fort Worth received word a couple of weeks ago that her husband had been liberated. A boy from Sweetwater, Stephenville, Austin and two from Waco have been liberated. Still, nothing has been heard from Amon Junior or about your son. I appreciate your letter and will keep you advised of any information we may receive.
