With the Red Cross food parcel every wk. the diet there is quite adequate but it gets very monotonous. The Red Cross is also furnishing adequate clothing.

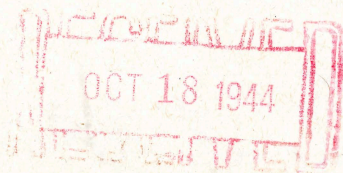
The Y.M.C.A. is doing a wonderful job of furnishing the P.O.W. with books,
