Lt. Amon Carter, Jr. Missing in Action In North Africa

FORT WORTH, Mar. 11. (UP) Lt. Annon G. Carter, Jr., son of Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram, is missing in action in North Africa, the War Department announced today.

Young Carter was 23.

The announcement, received by his father in a telegram from the War Department this morning, said Lt. Carter's artillery unit had been in action near Sbeilta in Northern Tunisia Feb. 14.

Lt. Carter graduated from Culver Military Academy, Culver, Ind., as a reserve officer and entered active service in July, 1941.

He trained at Fort Knox, Ky.

He was sent to Ireland and later to England. He moved to Africa with the Allied invasion.

Carter, Sr. visited his son when he was in Ireland and England for several weeks last fall.
