Amon Carter Notified Son Is Missing

FORT WORTH, March 11,— (UP)—Lt. Amon G. Carter, Jr., son of Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram, is missing in action in North Africa, the war department announced Thursday.

Young Carter was 23.

The announcement, received by his father in a telegram from the war department Thursday morning, said Lt. Carter's artillery unit had been in action near Sbeitla in Northern Tunisia Feb. 14.

Lt. Carter graduated from Culver Military academy, Culver, Ind., as a reserve officer and entered active service in July, 1941.

Young Carter, as a student at the University of Texas, was an amateur photographer and assisted Neal Douglass, Austin Statesman photographer, on several football assignments.
