I fully appreciate how you feel at the same time we must look on the matter with the most hopefull view possible and have as much courage as he has always displayed and with the feeling that he may be an Italian prisoner as others of his division have been later reported after first receiving similar message. Naturally we will keep you advised of any further deered o crate to provide so can a color to cook information received meanwhile there is nothing we can do except to keep our chin up and hope for the best.
