Amon Carter's Son Believed *90* To Be Prisoner

WITH U. S. FORCES IN SOUTHERN TUNISIA, March 3. (Delayed) (P)—Second Lt. Amon G. Carter, Jr., son of the Fort Worth, Texas, publisher, and a forward observer for a field artillery battalion, has been reported missing in action and is believed to be a prisoner in German hands.

Carter, who was described by his superior officers as "a fine officer," was established in an advanced observation post of Lessouda Hill facing Faid Pass when a German Panzer horde staged a Valentine's Day attack, February 14, in that region.
