in Tunisia - I am
encouraged however, and

majority of casualties
are missing & not killed.
Since he was in an
advanced Post he was
probably cut off by the
very rapid advance of

the Germans and is now
a Prisoner. I would think
there is a very good chance
that he will be back
with our forces before
long because it is
my sincere opinion
that Rommel will have
to surrender within the
near future.

In the meantime if
there is anything I can
do I know you will
let me know and I
shall hope & pray with
you that that fine boy
is safe.
