**AMON CARTER'S SON IS  
BELIEVED NAZI PRISONER**

WITH THE U. S. FORCES IN  
SOUTHERN TUNISIA, Mar. 13—  
Delayed—(AP)—Second Lieut. Amon  
G. Carter Jr., son of the Fort  
Worth, Texas, publisher, and a  
forward observer for a field artil-  
lery battalion, has been reported  
missing in action and is believed  
to be a prisoner in German hands.

Carter, who was described by his  
superior officers as "a fine offi-

cer," was established in an ad-  
vanced observation post on Lessou-  
day hill facing Faid pass when a  
German panzer horde staged a  
Valentine's day attack, Feb. 14, in  
that region.

Carter's father is president and  
publisher of the Fort Worth Star-  
Telegram.
