In Mr. Carter's absence from the city permit the writer to advise that he has received no additional information concerning his son Lt. Amon G. Carter, Jr., who was reported missing in action in the North African Area as of February 14. Mr. Carter has made every effort possible to secure further information about his son and others in the same outfit, but it seems the War Department has a very rigid policy and that they possibly do not have any further information to give.

Amon Jr. was in the 91st Field Artillery, Battery B, First Armored Division. So, as hard as it is to take, we must continue hoping and praying that these boys are prisoners and that they will eventually return to us.
