Wour letter of March 16 is very much appreciate and it was nice of you to give me the details of your friend's efforts in securing information concerning his son who was reported missing in action in Africa and I have already instigated inquiry through the same route, and if Amon Jr. should eventually be reported as a prisoner of war, perhaps we will eventually get some information about him. It has been 37 days now since he was reported missing and the only hope we have is that he is a prisoner. I too have known of instances where these boys reported missing have, within a month, been reported as prisoners of war. However, we have not been fortunate enough to receive such information as yet.
