Pacific on a destroyer. He
has recently been made
a Lieut. j.g. which made
me very proud of him.

We are all very proud
of our fine sons who are
having to fight this cruel
war but with our faith and
prayers and Gods will they
may come safely home.

Please remember me
to Mrs Deakin as I know

what she is young
then also as she loved
a man so much.
