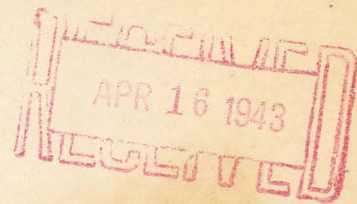


1204 Hawthorne
