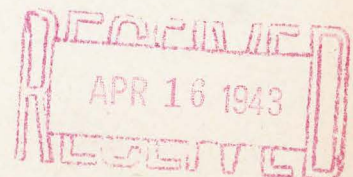
My dear Mr. Carter,

Amon Carter Jr. German Prisoner

FORT WORTH, April 15.—(AP)—Amon Carter, publisher of the Star-Telegram, had been advised officially today his son, Lieut. Amon Carter Jr., artillery officer who has been missing in action in Africa since February 14, was a prisoner of war in Germany.
