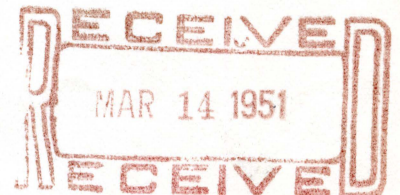

My dear Mr. Carter:
