Dear Mrs. Deakins:

Mr. Carter may ignore the "Notice to T-1 Holders" which was sent to him in routine.

His special pass No. 1 permits him to use must-ride transportation over the lines of the company. Our Form T-1 permits other employees and directors to use the same type of transportation. When the notice was sent, Mr. Carter was included because of the similarity of the two types of cards. Some of our employees have errands which are not so urgent as to justify positive transportation, and we are encouraging them to use so-called "space available" transportation on those occasions to avoid possibly displacing a revenue passenger.

I am sorry that we confused you and Mr. Carter.
