Publisher Ejected From A&M Field

HOUSTON, Nov. 28.—Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Record and Star-Telegram, today gave his version of an episode at College Station on Thursday when he gave three cheers for A&M and Dan Moody and was promptly escorted from the grounds.

Carter said he circled the runway at the foot of the stands crying "Hurrah for A&M and Dan Moody" and that at one time, without knowing he was near the gubernatorial box, stood behind Governor Ferguson and her husband and gave vent to his enthusiasm for the football team and the young attorney general. President T. O. Walton of A&M then tapped him on the shoulder and told him he would have to leave the field if he gave the cry again.

"Of course, when he said that, I retorted that I would continue to cheer for A&M and Mr. Moody, and he called a colonel of the governor's staff, I believe, and I was escorted out."
