Governor Ferguson and Amon G. Carter are now at outs. Mr. Carter is principal owner of the Star-Telegram, at Fort Worth. It is alleged that at the A. & M.-Varsity foot ball game last Thursday, Mr. Carter stood near the Governor and shouted for A. & M. and Dan Moody, and refusing to obey a request from the president of A. & M. to desist, was escorted from the grounds, but returned. Monday the Governor asked for the resignation of Mr. Carter as a member of the Board of Regents of the West Texas Technological College. In the letter asking for Mr. Carter's resignation the Governor said she had been informed that he had erected a bar in Fort Worth during the meeting of the oil men at Fort Worth and served intoxicants to hundreds of friends without cost, and that Mr. Carter also presented his friends with hollow canes that carried concealed phials, containing about a pint of beverage. The Governor also alleged that Mr. Carter was in a state of intoxication at the A. & M. game, and his deportment there was such that he should not longer remain on the governing body of a state educational institution.
