"The \$110,000 spent for surfacing in Denton county would have put six inches of gravel on every designated state highway in Denton county," said County Engineer Harris Monday in answer to a request for an estimate. "The surfacing was put on practically 350,000 square yards at a cost of \$110,000 to the state and at a cost to the contractor, by sub-contracts, of \$48,000, leaving a \$62,000 margin of profit." If the \$110,000 had been spent on surfacing, at the rate the sub-contractors did the work, it would have surfaced pretty nearly every mile of designated highway in Denton county.—Denton Record-Chronicle.
