Governor Mirlam A. Ferguson denies that the new highway but completed in Bell County, between Belton and Tem-

ple, was a Christmas present to the home people.

The lighway is a new form of road, constructed in a manner different from any roads in this section. The governor says that the road was built partly as an experiment, and prediets that the state of Texas will save many millions of dollars by building such highways in the future.

The governor says that the road was constructed in Bell County becaue of the central location of Bell County-not be-

cause Bell County is the Gobernor's home.

It is not the designation of the new highways in the governor's home count that so much affects the people of Texas as the undoubtedly irregular manner in which many millions of dollars of the state's highway money have been expended, wtthout competitive bidding and oftentimes at a price out of all reason. The governor could be permitted to make a Christ mas present to the people of Bell County each year much cheaper than to face "unconscionable" profits on highway builting and maintenance of all kinds, such as the Attorney General charges are now being made by the several companies enjoying contracts from the Highway Commission.
