AMON CARTER IS PUT OUT OF KYLE FIELD

Ft. Worth Publisher
Has Run-in with
College Head.

College Station, Texas, Nov. 27.—
(United Press)—Amon G. Carter, pub-
lisher of the Fort Worth Record-
Telegram was put off Kyle Field
where the Texas Aggies and Long-
horns played yesterday for shouting
“Hurrah for A. and M., and Dan
Moody.” Carter was said to have
walked back of the box occupied by
Governor Miriam A. Ferguson and
her official party to do his “rooting.”

President T. O. Walton, of A. and
M., college warned Carter to desist,
threatening to call officers. Carter
disregarded the college president, and
was escorted from the field by special
officers.

Says “Tempest in Teapot”

Houston, Texas, Nov. 27.—Amon G.
Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth
Record-Telegram, Friday explained his
ejection from the A. and M.-Texas
U., football game at College Station
Thursday for shouting “Hooray for
A. and M., and Dan Moody.”

Carter is visiting here. He was put
out of the stands when President T.
O. Walton, of A. and M., felt that
his rooting was objectionable to Gov-
ernor Ferguson, who was attending
the game.

“This is all a tempest in a tea-
pot,” Carter said. “I was merely
rooting for the Aggies and had no
desire to embarrass the governor.
There was nothing pointed in my
shouting.”

After being ejected from the game.
Mr. Carter was allowed to re-enter
and see the remainder of the game.
