President T. O. Walton, of A. and M., college warned Carter to desist, threatening to call officers. Carter disregarded the college president, and was escorted from the field by special

officers.

Carter is visiting here. He was put of the stands when President T. out of the stands when President T.D. Walton, of A. and M., felt that his rooting was objectionable to Governor Ferguson, who was attending

he game. "This is all a tempest in a ten-pot," Carter said. "I was merely cooting for the Aggies and had no lesire to embarrass the governor. There was nothing pointed in my shouting."

After being ejected from the game. Mr. Carter was allowed to re-enter and see the remainder of the game.
