Amon Carter Is Out as Chairman of Tech Board of Directors

Austin, Tex., Feb. 9.—Resignation of Amon G. Carter of Fort Worth as chairman of the board of directors of Texas Tech Friday was announced by Governor Dan Moody.

Appointment of Carl Phinney, former chief clerk of the house, assistant secretary to the governor was also made public.

The unexpected resignation of Phinney as chief clerk of the house at noon adjournment and attempts to elect his assistant, Miss Louise Snow of Lyford, to the vacancy, by acclamation, brought insinuations of "railroading" from Representative George Purl. Representative Rawlins of Dallas, had nominated Miss Snow and another motion called for close of nominations.

Purl got the floor and declared that while he probably would vote for Miss Snow he believed other possible candidates should be given this chance.

"This legislature should not be in the attitude of railroading a thing over," Purl declared.

Further discussion in which both speaker R. L. Bobbitt and Rawlins refuting any intimation at "railroading" resulted in a house vote to recess until 1:30 p. m. and settle the matter.
