# CARTER TELLS OF "OUSTING"

## Nothing Pointed in Rooting, Says

Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram, Friday explained his "ejection" from the A.&M.-Texas U. game at College Station Thanksgiving for shouting "Hooray for A.&M. and Dan Moody."

Carter is visiting Will C. Hogg here. He was put out of the stands when President T. O. Walton of A.&M. felt that his rooting was objectionable to Governor and Jim Ferguson, who were attending the game.

"This is all a tempest in a teapot," Carter said. "I was merely rooting for the Aggies and had no desire to embarrass the governor or her husband. There was nothing pointed in my shouting."

### Didn't Think It Right

Carter said he had walked up and down the stands several times when President Walton asked him to stop shouting for Moody.

"I told him I was a taxpayer and thought that I could howl for any one I wished," Carter said he told him. "He said that if I did n't stop, he'd put me out and called a staff officer nearby.

"I told him that I didn't think he was doing the right thing, but that I submitted to his authority. The officer then walked down the field with me and turned me over to another officer who walked just outside the stand with me.

"Is it against the law to holler for A. & M. here?" I asked him. "Is it against the law to holler for Dan Moody?"

"No," he said.

"Well, then, what's all the shooting for?" I asked him.

"Aw, come on; let's go back in," he answered and we both came in and sa wthe rest of the game.

### No Differences

Carter said he had no differences with Walton, had supported him and would continue to do so. He said that while his paper differed in policy with the Fergusons he wouldn't insult them "for the world."

"Did you say anything 'about road contracts," Carter was asked.

"No, not a thing. Well, yes I did, too," he answered, "but it was just in a joking manner. When I was down at the other end of the field, I shouted 'Well, If Texas loses we'll give them a couple of road contracts.'"
