Carter Is Asked To Resign

AUSTIN, Nov. 30.—Governor Ferguson has requested the resignation of Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Record and Star-Telegram, as a member of the board of directors of the West Texas Technological College. The request was in the form of a letter addressed to Carter.

The Governor, in the letter, charged that Carter violated the prohibition law when he invited "some two or three hundred guests to whom he dispensed stimulating drinks and gave away souvenir pints."

Amon G. Carter is undecided whether or not he will resign as requested by the Governor. Carter told the United Press that the Governor is attempting to divert the attention of the public from Highway matters and is using this method of accomplishing that.
