Carter Says Didn't Aim to Embarrass Ma

HOUSTON, Texas, Nov. 28.—Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Record-Telegram, explained his ejection from the Texas University-A. & M. football game at College Station Thursday for shouting "Hurrah for A. & M. and Dan Moody."

Carter is visiting here. He was put out of the stands when President T. O. Walton of A. & M. felt that his rooting was objectionable to Gov. Ferguson, who was attending the game.

"This is all a tempest in a teapot," Carter said. "I was merely rooting for the Aggies and had no desire to embarrass the Governor. There was nothing pointed in my shouting."

After being ejected from the game, Carter was allowed to re-enter and see the remainder of the game.
