## AMON G. CARTER QUITS AS REGENT

Austin, Feb. 5. — Governor Moody has announced the resignation of Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram from the board of regents of the Texas Technological College.

Carter gave as reason for his resignation that "pressing business would soon take him out of the state to such an extent he could not adequately discharge the duties of the office." It is generally said in Austin, however, that he resigned because Governor Moody refused to name Ex-Mayor Milam of Fort Worth a member of the highway commission.

Carter's resignation, which has

been rumored two weeks, was nevertheless surprising since he might almost be called the "original Moody man." At the University of Texas-A. & M. football game in the fall of 1925, Carter attracted attention by yelling, "Hurrah for Dan Moody and the Highway investigation" within earshot of Governor Miriam A. Ferguson's box.
