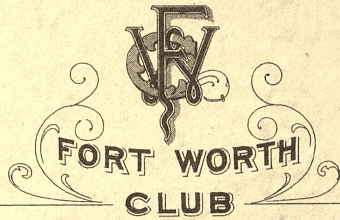

will be here tomorrow

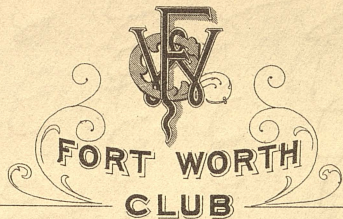

your heart

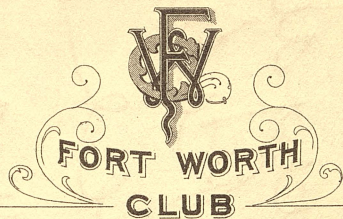
