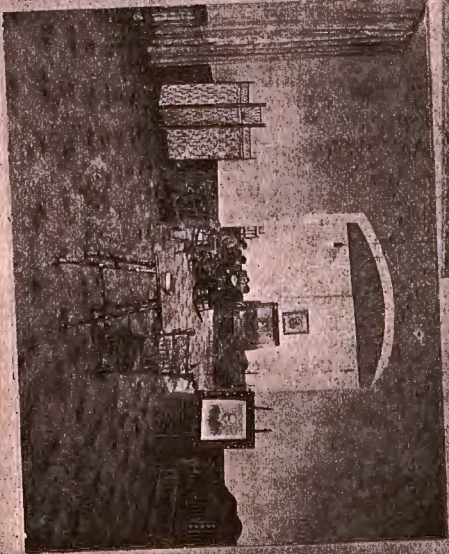
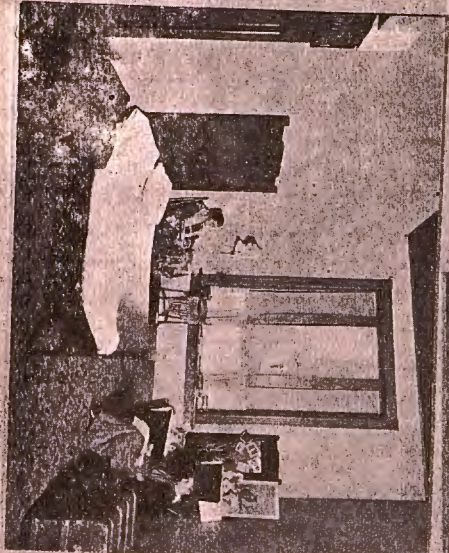
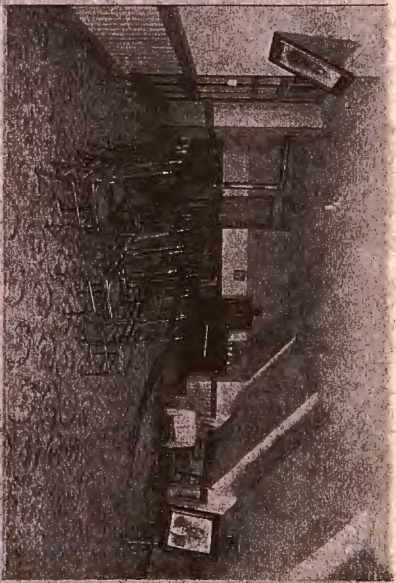


ADD-RAN UNIVERSITY—FRONT VIEW.
