The stock market slowly halted a quiet morning decline. Closing prices showed a clear majority of losses running to around one dollar a share. Early losses had amounted to as much as two dollars a share. Trading slowed to a normal rate for the first time since the Korean fighting agitated the market last week. Transfers approximated 1,600,000 shares.
