Amon Carter, Jr., Is In Nazi Camp With Three Other Texans

May 1.-Fort Fort/ Worth Publisher Amon Carter has learned that his son, Lt. Amon Carter, Jr., now a prisoner in Ger-many, hid for nine days behind the Central Tunisian German

lines before his capture.

In a letter to his mother, Lieutenant Carter, an artillery officer, reported missing in action February 14 near Sbeitla, said he was captured by the Germans Febru-ary 23, flown out of Africa to Italy, then put on a train and taken into Germany.

With him in his present camp, he said, are three other Texans: Lts. George Beazley of Ennis, Ed Batte of Waxahachie, and John Jones, Jr., of Houston. His letter reported good treat-

ment.
