I have learned by today's post from Merrill Meigs, that your boy is safe, although a prisoner.

I cannot tell you how immensely relieved and glad I am! Only a parent who has been through it knows the hell it can be; it must have been particularly hard in your case as he was your only boy, and such a fine boy at that. All your friends here were distressed when I told them he was missing. Several of them wrote to you I believe, but I cannot recall that any of them have had a reply; the post is taking such a time at present.

I trust I shall have the pleasure of seeing you again soon, and I hope and pray that your boy, with mine, will be restored to freedom quickly.

I do think that on this side of the water we are giving them a "pasting" now - how long they can stand up to it remains to be seen.
