Camp, and I have ~~very~~ hoped that you would be getting word that he has been liberated by the Russians. I miss the news from Fort Worth these days, and I would like to ask a favour of you. Would you send me a subscription to the Star-Telegram, to be sent to the above address? If you would then let me know the cost of the subscription I could send you a money order by return mail. It is very cheering to be able to read about the people you have called your friends for so many years, and about the place that I will always call home.

The tempo of our activities over here is stepping up considerably now that we are getting a few more days of good flying weather each succeeding month. The end is in sight, I hope! Sincerely Elliott Roosevelt
