Dear Mr. Carter:

Just received your letter of January 26th enclosing B.E.W. license forms to be used in the mailing of 200 ROBT. BURNS Panatela de Luxe cigars to your son, Lt. Amon G. Carter, Jr. and your check in payment thereof is herewith acknowledged. The package will be mailed immediately.

Was interested to know that you received a letter from Amon, Jr. on January 13th advising that he and his companions were getting along all right, but that a great many of them needed winter overcoats.

Can sympathize with the way you feel, as expressed in your letter, and how you must constantly have on your mind the difficulties and privations which your son has to undergo as a prisoner in the hands of Germany, but it must give you some comfort to hear from him from time to time and we can only pray that the time is not far distant when these young men, who have served us so bravely and have suffered so much, will return once more to their homes and to their native land.

I do hope that your next letter from Amon, Jr. will bring more comforting news with regard to his condition.
