The Provost Marshal General directs me to inform you that the German Government has refused to permit tobacco and tobacco products to be included in next of kin parcels to American prisoners of war. However, a special committee consisting of representatives from the War, Navy, and State Departments, Office of Economic Warfare, Post Office Department, Office of Censorship, and American Red Cross has made arrangements with several tobacco companies whereby tobacco products may be mailed by tobacco companies direct to officially reported American prisoners of war in Europe, when place of internment is known.

There are inclosed for your possible use two tobacco labels with blank order forms attached. Each label will now permit you to send two units as shown below. Please note that a unit consists of three cartons of cigarettes or 100 cigars, or 24 ounces of chewing tobacco, unless stated otherwise, or 24 ounces of smoking tobacco, unless stated otherwise. Each order form attached to the label may be used for one or two units as you desire. You may send three or six cartons of cigarettes or the equivalent in other kinds of tobacco for each label received by you. Orders may not be mixed. For example, smoking tobacco may not be included in the same package with cigars or cigarettes. Your cooperation in strictly following these instructions is requested.

In using these labels, select the company you desire, properly fill in the order attached to the label indicating on the order whether you desire one or two units of the various item numbers, inclose a money order in the proper amount, and forward direct to the tobacco company. Do not fill in your name and address under the word "Sender". This is for the company you select. Fill in the order blank only. Each label must be used within the date stamped thereon. You will note that the prices charged are exclusive of internal revenue taxes, as arrangements have been made whereby these items may be forwarded without the payment of taxes or postage. The tobacco companies have agreed to pack such tobacco products as you may order and mail the package direct from the factory to the prisoner of war using the inclosed label. The tobacco companies are selling their products at cost.
