Letters and cards have been received this week dated February 11, 14th, March 1 and 8, which is the first we have heard in five or six weeks and we were quite worried and anxious as to whether the boys in Oflag 64 had been moved out of "reach" of the Russian Army who are getting close. This camp is in Schubin on the Vistula rivier about 100 miles South of Danzig.
