Dear Mrs. Cannon:

Your letter of December 11 has been received, and it is a pleasure to send you a set of the pictures taken of the boys in Oflag 64, Germany and they would have been sent sooner had I known your address. You may keep them as they are copies of the originals.

Only last week I received a card dated September 14 from Amon Junior and at that time he advised that they had not had any packages in three months. I have communicated with the National Red Cross Headquarters and they advise that food and clothing parcels have been sent to the camp. Of course we may expect a disruption of transportation and mail, I know it doesn't relieve your anxiety as I know how disturbed I have been over these boys. So all we can do is wait and hope that it will all come out all right.
