Thanks so kindly for your thoughtfulness in sending the pictures for us to look at which you received from Lt. Meadows. I took the liberty of keeping them two days and having negatives made of the two pictures that Bill is in. I sent them on to Bill's wife, an Army Nurse at Fort Bragg, this morning and she will promptly mail them to you direct.

Bill is the man on the right hand side of the picture where four men are standing on the steps he being the only one not wearing a heavy coat. You can tell from his jump boots. Then he is also on the right hand side on the steps again where six men are in the picture, two rows of three each, with a tall man in long overcoat in the middle of the first row. Does you son happen to be in either of these pictures? I would very much like to know which one is Amon, Jr. if he is.

I received a letter this morning from Chris, Bill's wife, and she had received some other snaps from Lt. Meadows and he is bringing her a painting Bill made and sent to her. We are all very anxious to hear the news after his visit at Bragg. He was formerly stationed there.
