Dear Mrs. Cole:

Mr. Carter is still out of the city,
so I am answering your letter to him of October 7th.

The pictures were for you to keep
and are copies of those received by Mr. Carter.

Amon Junior was in the pictures
numbers 1, 2, and 3 and the description on an
attached sheet of paper was enclosed with a copy
of Lt. Meadows' letter and numbered correspondingly
with the pictures. In the pictures of the five boys
wearing overcoats, Amon Junior is in the center.
In the group of five boys standing on the steps in
which your son is on the right, Amon Junior is second
from the left on. In the group of all Texas boys, about
30 of them, on the steps, Amon Junior is third from
the left on the second row. It doesn't appear in
any of the funeral service scenes and I rather think
he might have taken these pictures as he is quite
a photographer.

I am so anxious to hear what Lt. Meadows
might have to tell your son's wife and wonder if you
will pass the information on to Mr. Carter when he has
visited Fort Bragg?
