Gentlemen:

The February issue of Culver Alumnus arrived this morning and I notice on page 8, under the heading "Prisoners of War" that the address of Amon G. Carter, Jr., is given as Oflag 9, A/Z, Germany.

May I advise you that last June he was moved from that particular camp and is now interned at Oflag 64, Germany. This particular camp is located in Poland about 100 miles South of Danzig. We hear from him regularly every four or five weeks. The writer received a letter from him dated January 17th which arrived here March 2nd and he seemed to still be in good spirits and making the best of the situation.
