Wonder if you have any news of our boys. My latest letter from Ivan is still the one of Dec. 10th and received here on Jan. 10th. He seemed in fairly good spirits at that time, but didn't say much.

Mrs. Joe Emerson, of Handley, wrote you sent telegrams to all the Texans, do you have any more information - besides that - that the Camp of Oflag 64 has been moved to Legau, Germany, 80 miles southeast of Berlin. I keep hoping the Russians reach them before the Germans have a chance to move them - again.

Ivan's brother, in Ft. Worth has a card from him Dec. 13th received Jan. 15th. Mrs. Emerson has a card Dec. 14th from Capt. Emerson. Wonder if anyone has any later news.

Are you still writing Amos to the old address at Oflag 64, or

do you have a new address, Mr.
Carter?

Hoping we all hear good news
soon and all the husbands, sons
and sweethearts will be on their way
home.

Let me hear from you. I'm always
interested ⁱⁿ any news you have of Amos.

Have you seen any of Harry Allen's
articles? I've just finished the one in
Jan. Cosmopolitan, that's only one I've
had a chance to read.
